

Privacy Policy

Ronald McDonald House Charities of Denver, Inc. (RMHC Denver) is pleased to provide information to all of its customers about its online privacy policy. Please be assured that RMHC of Denver. uses its best efforts to protect the privacy of visitors to this web site.

Types of Information We Collect and How It Is Used

RMHC Denver only gathers personal information, such as, first and last names, home addresses, email addresses and credit card numbers, when voluntarily submitted by you. If you make an online donation, personal information will be collected from you in order to process that donation.

With your permission, we will use personal information collected from you to send you information, such as, RMHC Denver updates or information regarding new Ronald McDonald House Charities of Denver openings, fund-raising campaigns or major grant initiatives. If you do not elect to receive such materials, we will not send them to you.

Sharing of Personal Information

Companies may be engaged by RMHC Denver to perform a variety of functions, such as, assisting with donation collection, providing technical services for our web sites, etc. These companies may have access to personal information if needed to perform such functions. However, these companies may only use such personal information for the purpose of performing that function and may not use it for any other purpose. Other than as provided in this privacy policy, RMHC Denver does not sell, transfer or disclose personal information to third parties.

RMHC Denver reserves the right to use or disclose any information as needed to satisfy any law, regulation or legal request, to protect the integrity of the site, to fulfill your requests, or to cooperate in any law enforcement investigation or an investigation on a matter of public safety.

Access

You are in control of any personal information you provide to us on-line. Cookies

"Cookies" are pieces of information that a web site transfers to an individual's hard drive for record-keeping purposes. Cookies allow the web site to remember important information that will make your use of the site more convenient. For example, we track the total number of visitors to our site on an anonymous aggregate basis. We may also employ cookies so that we remember you when you return to the site. Security and Payment Processing

We employ commercially reasonable security methods and technologies to help secure the Personal Information we collect and store. However, no system can be guaranteed 100% secure. We therefore cannot ensure or warrant the security of any information that you transmit to us, or that we transmit to you, or guarantee that it will be free from unauthorized access by third parties.

We use a vendor to process credit card payments made through the Site and to store associated payment data, so RMHC Denver does not directly collect such credit card information, nor does RMHC Denver store or have access to credit card information submitted online. For donations made offline RMHC may directly collect, store or have access to credit card information for processing payments.

Social Networking Features

Functionality on the Site may permit interactions that you initiate between the Site and a third-party website or service such as Twitter or Facebook (Social Networking Features"). Examples of Social Networking features include enabling you to "like" or share" content from the Site or to "like or "share" our page on a third-party service; to automatically or selectively show your social media posts/tweets on the Site; to create a RMHC account or RMHC personal profile using existing login information from a from a social-network (known as a social login): and to otherwise connect the Site to a third-party website or service. If you choose to share content or to otherwise post information through the Site to a third-party site or service, or vice versa, that information may be publicly displayed. Business Transfer & Transitions

By providing your Personal information, you agree that we may transfer such information to the acquiring entity without your further consent.
